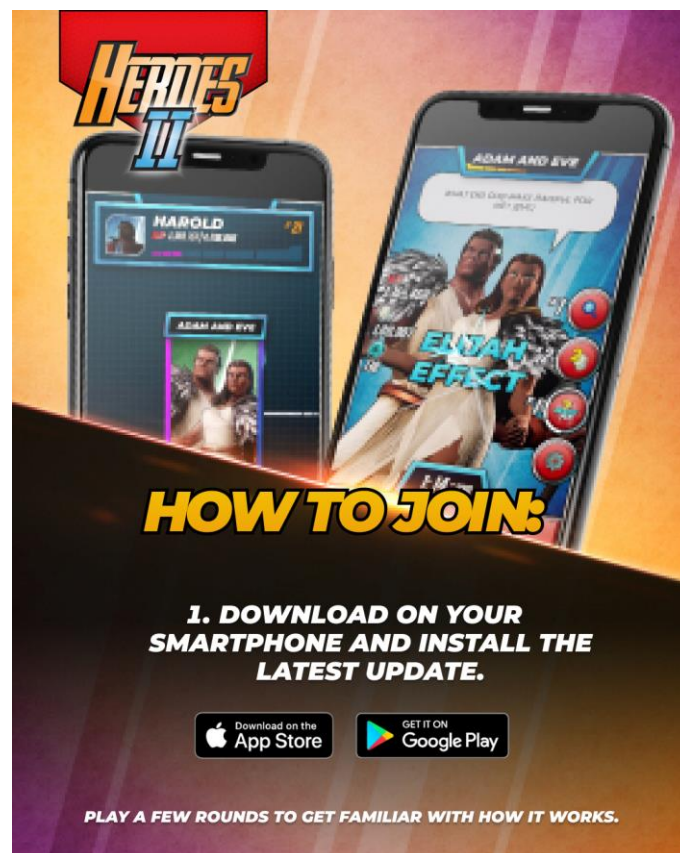
### Instructions

  - c. The game will start when we publish the qualifier link on the website
  - d. Be quick, the qualifier will last only 15 min.
  - e. The top 4 people from each conference will go through to the semi-final round which is LIVE on the same zoom meeting on August 6, Friday at 3:00 pm.

### SUGGESTED ACTS OF KINDNESS (Adapted from Global Youth Day 2021)

Each church should focus on creating a #Connected campaign that will inspire daily acts of kindness throughout the entire church. The goal is to integrate daily acts of kindness into our lifestyles, both as individuals and as a church.

During this COVID-19 pandemic, #Connected participants are to follow health and social distancing protocols for the safety of everyone. If in-person outreach ministry is not possible, it is highly recommended that outreach activities be held virtually.

### Use Technology

- Post varying scripture and uplifting messages on all forms of social media during GYD
- Post uplifting videos

- Write personalized direct messages to specific individuals
- Record personalized video messages of motivation and encouragement to individuals who need it. Ensure to mention their name.
- Run a Facebook or Instagram Ad in your area, promoting that you offer prayer, food, clothing, mentorship, or just a listening ear for anyone who needs it.
- Post on Facebook, Twitter, and Instagram the Act or Acts of Kindness you've done using the hashtags #ConnectedCamporee #CPCActsofKindness #GYD21

**Visit families in your community who have been affected by a tragedy such as death, disaster, critical illness, etc.**

- Write them a letter on behalf of the church, include a card
- Visit the affected families via Zoom, Skype, or other online platforms
- Worship with them, pray with them virtually
- Carry a gift basket and do a "drive by" to deliver it

**Visit the Homeless, persons in jail, persons in shelters (abused women, orphans, persons on drugs, etc.)**

- Create care packages with toothbrushes, toothpaste, soap, deodorant, snacks, gloves, warm socks, and evangelistic literature, etc.) and hand them out to the homeless in your church community (Note: Participants should wear masks and comply with social distancing regulations).
- Prepare healthy snack bags (sandwiches, fruits, water, drinks, etc.)
- Donate new or used clothing in a good state
- Worship with them, pray with them
- Give literature (check with your Personal Ministries Department ahead of time)

**For Sick / Shut-ins / Persons in need of assistance**

- o Prepare food baskets
- o Share literature (The Great Controversy, Steps to Christ, Desire of Ages, magazines, etc.)
- o Virtual singing bands
- o Send recorded messages, songs, and prayers via WhatsApp, Messenger, etc.
- o Call and ask how they are. Pray for them.
- o Surprise them with a visit and bring flowers or a card.
- o Bring a meal over.

**At the Orphanage**

- o Share Bible stories
- o Hand out toys (toys must be new or in very good, usable condition)
- o Clothing (clothes must be new or in very good, usable condition)
- o Share songs (sing-alongs)
- o Give age appropriate books

**Visit a Nursing Home**

- o Arrange to play an instrument or sing at a nursing home in your area (virtually).
- o Help with crafts.
- o Help serving meals.
- o Pray for someone.
- o Take flowers for the ladies.
- o Get a young person to adopt a senior for a day

**At the Orphanage**

- Share Bible stories
- Worship with them, pray with them
- Hand out toys (toys must be new or in very good, usable condition)
- Clothing (clothes must be new or in very good, usable condition)
- Share songs (sing-alongs)
